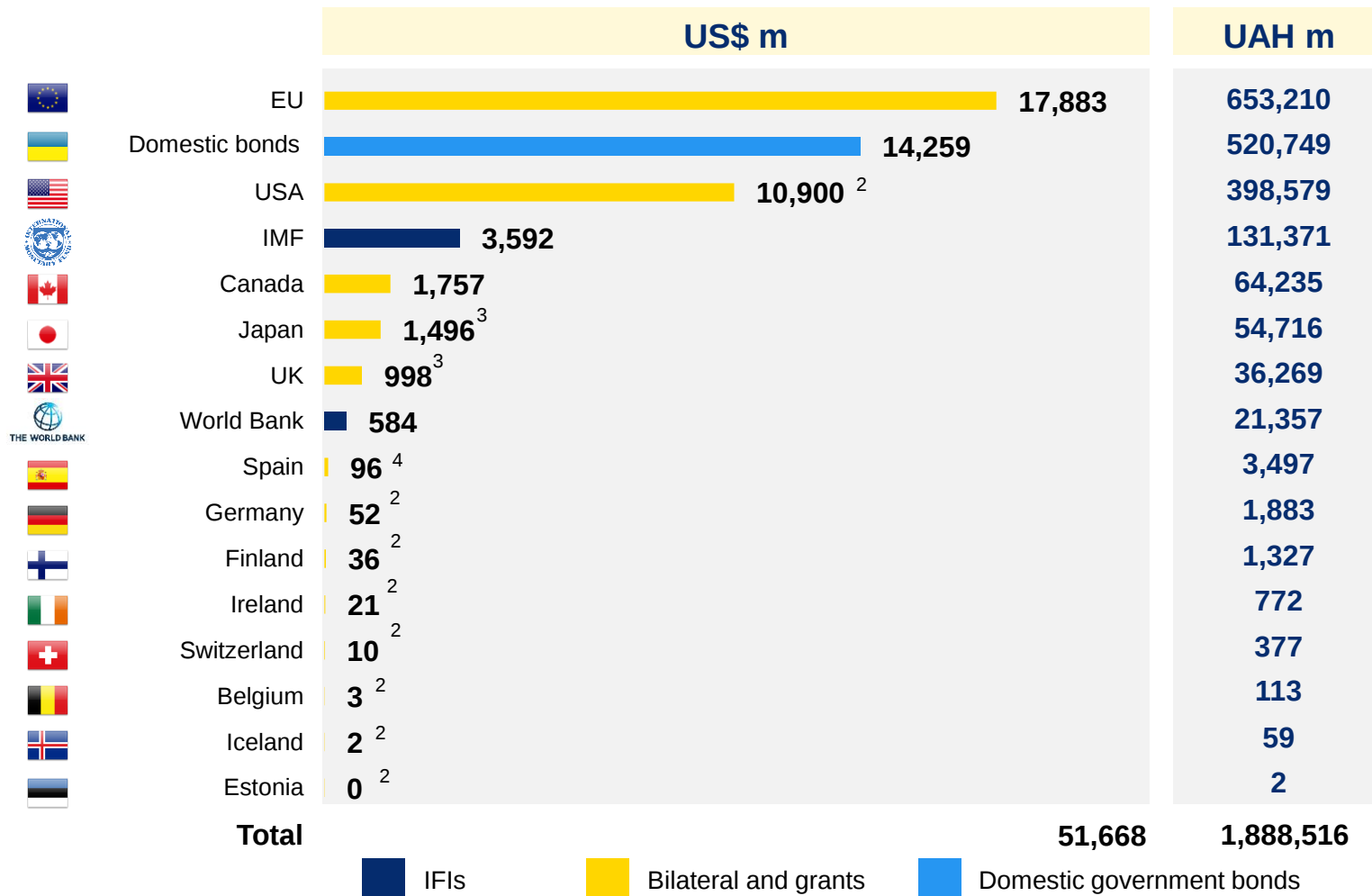


The sources of Ukraine's state budget financing in 2023 are the war bonds as well as bilateral loans and grants
